

Four New Shopping Centers: Supernova Group Expands Further in Slovakia

Austria / Slovakia: Supernova, the Graz-based retail property and real estate group, has been active in the Slovakian market since 2016, with a total of 11 OBI stores. Recently, Supernova acquired its first multi-tenant objects in the country. The transaction includes four shopping centers, which are run under the name Max, and are located in the regional capitals of Trnava, Trencin, Nitra and Poprad. Each location includes commercial space of around 15,000 square meters, summing up to a total volume of more than 60,000 square meters.

The projects have been integral parts in their respective local community for more than a decade and offer a broad range of stores, restaurants, event locations and cinemas. Anchor tenants include Billa, New Yorker, Kik, Tedi, Sinsay and Decathlon, all international shop partners found in other Supernova properties, and Max movie theaters. Markus Pinggera, Supernova Group CEO, on the latest acquisitions: "It's great that we have been able to make this step, taking a key real-estate position in retail in the fifth market for us."

Supernova will undertake a visual and technical overhaul of the projects, including a particular focus on green topics. All new four centers will be optimized and certified to the green energy efficient standard, as it is being rolled out in all other Supernova centers. Supernova is committed to reach net-zero status by the end of 2023, including the new acquisitions in Slovakia.
